FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

What are the options to attend?

- Host a live webcast viewing
- Attend a webcast hosted by another organization in your community
- Attend in person in Baltimore, MD.

What options are there for me to watch the live webcast?

Outside of a local audience in Baltimore the live webcast license is the only ticket available.

Can I register as an individual?

There are no individual attendance options.

How long should I schedule my event for?

The core hours are per the schedule listed at the end of this document, but we encourage you to add time for discussion.

How much should I charge?

This is completely up to you. You can consider charging a fee or can make it free for all.

Are there additional charges from the NACG?

No. The fee to play the webcast live is the only fee payable.

What technology should I have in place?

You need a wireless connection to connect to zoom and the ability to have those in the room see and hear the presentation.

Can I host the conference at a different time?

The event is a webcast of a live event. If you wish to host at a different date or time, then you are welcome to purchase the recording of the event. It will be available on our website after the event. Please note there are no CE credits available for purchase if using the recording playback.

Can I get a local sponsor?

Yes, you are welcome to get a local sponsor for the event to underwrite your costs.

How long before the event should I log in?

We will begin and end promptly. Please log in at least 15 minutes before so that you are online and ready to go at the beginning of the event.

What should I do if I have access issues?

Will CEs be available for my attendees?

The NACG have applied for CEs for the event. \$45 will be due to the NACG at the close of the event for those wishing to purchase CEs. The local host will support attendees in signing in and out so we can record attendance. You will have the option to opt out of providing CE's when you sign up to host.

Organizations, not individual courses, are approved as ACE providers. Social workers completing this course will receive 3 continuing education credits.


